


Who was a Tomas Bata?

General view of Tomas Bata

- changed craft to factory production
- developed own management system
- spread production of shoes to 36 other production fields
- in 1928 Czechoslovakia was the biggest shoes exporter in the world
- in 1929 Tomas Bata was estimated to be one of 100 richest people in the world
- Bata brand was famous in 4 continents


Service and Time


